能 is more like physical possibility



能 / 可以  
Permission or Request

会

huì

"Can" for physical or mental abilities, specifically for learned knowledge.  
Use it for actions you know how to do because you acquired the skill as a result of study.

我会开车                      I can drive a car (I know how to drive)  
你会开车吗?                Do you know how to drive a car?

能

néng

"Can" by circumstances,  
as being able to do something as a result of required circumstances.

我能开车                      I am capable to drive a car  
你能开车吗?                Are you capable of driving a car?

可以

kě yǐ

"Can" as expressing permission to do something.  
In English, 可以 (kě yǐ) is probably better translated as "may" or "could", although "can" is obviously less formal and more commonly used.

我可以开车                      I can / would drive a car (Have the implication)  
你可以开车吗?                May you drive a car?
